LDAF, county agents get update on citrus disease

The LSU AgCenter held a training meeting July 29 for county agents and Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry personnel outlining the proper steps homeowners with citrus should take if they believe their trees are infected with citrus canker disease.

Since the disease was confirmed in citrus trees in New Orleans City Park in June, LSU AgCenter specialists and agents have been trying to get accurate information to homeowners as well as commercial growers, according to LSU AgCenter plant scientist Raj Singh.

"The main message is for homeowners to not move samples of leaves or branches from the suspected trees," Singh said. "The disease is highly contagious and can be transferred to other trees just by handling infected trees."

Singh instructed those in attendance to have homeowners take a picture of the suspected leaves or fruit and email it to their AgCenter county agent, who can be found at www.LSUAgcenter.com.

So far, the disease has only been confirmed in Orleans and Jefferson parishes, but county agents from as far away as Lake Charles attended the Hammond meeting.

Citrus canker disease, which was last seen in Louisiana in the mid-1900s, can devastate the citrus industry if proper steps are not taken once it's observed, Singh said.

"It is a serious disease of citrus because it causes defoliation, premature fruit drop, blemished fruits and tree decline, and ultimately the infected tree stops producing fruit," Singh said.

The pathogen can cause symptoms on all young, above-ground

plant parts. Symptoms on leaves start as tiny raised blisters that may enlarge and become tan or brown as the disease develops.

"Lesions are visible on both sides of the leaves with water-soaked margins surrounded by a yellow halo," Singh said. "As the lesion ages, the center becomes raised and corky and may fall out, giving it a shot-hole appearance."

The disease was first found in City Park by a USDA inspector who was out jogging and just happened to see

"If growers would send their photo to the county agent in their parish, the agent would then forward the photos to the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, Plant Protection and Quarantine division for confirmation," he said.

Bill Spitzer, the USDA plant health director in Baton Rouge, said once his office is advised of the location of a suspected tree, they will respond to confirm the disease.

Spitzer said a survey team from Florida is in Louisiana now, but so far they have only confirmed the disease in Orleans and Jefferson parishes.

"I believe the disease has been in the state for more than a year now," Spitzer said. "If that holds true, then the track of Hurricane Isaac last August could very well have pushed it farther west."


The bacteria can survive on weeds growing under the infected trees, Singh said. "Once the disease is confirmed, the tree will have to be destroyed with a two-year waiting period before planting another citrus there."

The disease was first detected in Florida in 1910 and soon spread to other Gulf States including Louisiana, Singh said.

The last time the disease was seen in Louisiana was in 1940, when 1789 trees in six parishes were found positive in the state.

"We highly urge Louisiana residents to not move any infected citrus plant material within or out of state and to report any suspected trees to Bill Spitzer, state plant health director, at william.e.spitzer@aphis.usda.gov or 225-298-5410," Singh said.

the infected tree, Singh said.

LSU AgCenter county agent Barton Joffrion from Terrebonne Parish said even though the disease hasn't been found in his area, which includes Lafourche Parish, he wants to make sure he has all the facts just in case it does appear.

"We know that this is a serious disease that is highly volatile," Joffrion said. "There are no preventive measures yet that have been identified."

Joffrion reinforced the message of not trying to bring in samples from trees that may be infected.

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Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

FSA designates three La. parishes disaster areas

Louisiana Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., received notice July 31, 2013, from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) that counties and parishes in Mississippi, Louisiana and Alabama are now designated natural disaster areas.

The declaration is the result of losses caused by a freeze that occurred March 25, 2013, through March 29, 2013.

Mississippi counties designated primary natural disaster areas are: Clarke, Copiah, Covington, Forrest, George, Greene, Hancock, Harrison, Jackson, Jones, Lamar, Lauderdale, Leflore, Lincoln, Marion, Pearl River, Perry, Pike, Stone, Walthall and Wayne.

Mississippi counties designated contiguous disaster areas are: Amite, Carroll, Claiborne, Franklin, Grenada, Hinds,

Holmes, Humphreys, Jasper, Jefferson, Jefferson Davis, Kemper, Lawrence, Neshoba, Newton, Rankin, Simpson, Smith, Sunflower and Tallahatchie.

Contiguous disaster areas in other states:

Alabama counties: Choctaw, Mobile, Sumter and Washington

Louisiana parishes: St. Tammany, Tangipahoa and Washington

A Secretarial disaster designation makes farm operators in primary and contiguous areas eligible to be considered for certain assistance from the Farm Service Agency (FSA), provided eligibility requirements are met. This assistance includes low interest FSA emergency loans.



Fungicide-resistant soybean disease found in La.

An LSU AgCenter plant pathologist warned farmers at the St. Landry Parish rice and soybean field day on July 25 that fungicide-resistant disease has been found in soybeans in some areas of the state.

The soybean disease aerial blight has developed resistance to fungicides, said LSU AgCenter plant pathologist Clayton Hollier. "That's very troubling."

The problem was not unexpected because the rice disease called sheath blight had developed resistance to strobilurin fungicides in the north central area of Acadia Parish in the Mowata community, Hollier said. It has spread to several other nearby parishes.

Sheath blight and aerial blight are basically the same disease, he said.

Hollier cautioned farmers against using low rates of fungicides. He said the practice saves money, but it helps select disease that can survive fungicide applications.

Asian soybean rust has been found in scattered areas throughout the state, but it has not become a problem in commercial fields, Hollier said.

LSU AgCenter rice breeder Steve Linscombe gave an overview of ongoing work at the Rice Research Station to develop new varieties.

Two hybrid lines have done well in tests, but they are too tall for commercial release, Linscombe said, and work on more hybrids is progressing.

"Within a year or two, we're going to be talking about coming out with a commercial hybrid variety," he said.

LSU AgCenter entomologist Mike Stout said the stink bug threshold probably will be increased as the result of ongoing research. Currently, the threshold is 30 insects per 100 sweeps for the first two weeks after heading, and 100 insects per 100 sweeps made later than two weeks after heading.

LSU AgCenter rice specialist Johnny Saichuk said stink bugs are a bigger pest than usual. He said a field in north-

east Louisiana resulted in 15 stink bugs in just one sweep.

But unlike last year, Saichuk said, he has not found any blast disease.

The biggest problem farmers are having is uneven maturity, Saichuk said. Otherwise, this year's crop looks good.

LSU AgCenter weed scientist Eric Webster said he is testing a number of new herbicide products for grasses and broadleaf weeds. He said a Gowan product now used in corn is being tested for use in water-seeded rice.

LSU AgCenter soybean specialist Ron Levy said 180 varieties were planted throughout the state at seven locations to get an idea of yield potential. Levy advised growers to select varieties that perform well statewide.

LSU AgCenter agronomist Dustin Harrell said a new product by the Yaravera company combines ammonium sulphate with nitrogen to reduce nitrogen volatilization.

LSU AgCenter plant pathologist Don Groth said rice farmers should continue to scout for disease.

"Once a disease such as sheath blight is in the top of the canopy, there's nothing you can do," Groth said. "The damage has already occurred."

LSU AgCenter entomologist Jeff Davis urged farmers to rotate insecticides to control stink bugs in soybeans. He said overdependence on acephate is resulting in resistance.

With three to five applications needed for soybeans, he said, farmers also should consider using pyrethroids and neonicotinoids.

LSU AgCenter weed scientist Donnie Miller said herbicide-resistant Italian ryegrass problems can be prevented if fields are kept burned down in the fall before the plants have a chance to become established.

LSU AgCenter economist Kurt Guidry said soybeans are expected to stay in the \$13-\$14 per bushel range, and rice will sell for \$24-\$27 a barrel.

Randy Jemison of the USA Rice Federation gave an update on the farm bill deliberations.
