All Things Tractor!

Some people's passion is art, others love cars, but for lifelong Hammond resident Charlie Ciolino, it's tractors!

"My grandfather, Mike Ciolino, was one of the first people in Tangipahoa Parish who owned a tractor. He did tractor work for people and then started buying and selling used tractors. He had a vegetable farm and he also worked cattle during that time. You did what you could back then to make money," said Ciolino.

Ciolino's father also worked at a tractor dealership and a tractor parts store. In the 1990s, the family bought their own tractor dealership. But it's the old tractors that are extra special to Ciolino.

"When I see an old tractor, all I want to do is fix it up. It's amazing the changes that have taken place over the years. I hate seeing them go to the scrap yard, although my mom, Trudy, says I have my own personal junk yard," added Ciolino.

But what may be considered junk to some is what Ciolino refers to as preserving history. "I love the stories of who owned the tractor and what they did with it." Ciolino keeps 22 refurbished tractors in a storage area under his home. Overall, he says he has about 40, but he's lost count.

Ciolino says he rarely sells his tractors but he has given up a few only to invest in other tractors. "Sometimes it's hard to convince someone to sell their tractor. I worked on a guy for two years to sell me his

tractor. When he finally did, he said, 'You REALLY want this tractor.'"

Ciolino says Louisiana sugarcane farmers were known for their high crop tractors. "What you started seeing was people from up north buying up these tractors. That's history leaving our state!"

Ciolino started collecting tractors in the 1980s. The first one he bought and restored was a 1936 Farmall F-12. Ciolino said he literally cut trees out of it and pulled it out of the woods in Covington. He even got it up and running. He says collectors are always searching for that rare tractor because that's the "keeper."

Ciolino hunts for tractors like someone would go antiquing. "There are tractors in barns that are just sitting there. That's the one I want to see." Ciolino says he often travels the countryside of Louisiana to see if someone has an old tractor they're willing to sell. "I'm checking out the weeds, barns, even the woods." These days, he also peruses the internet. He's even bought a tractor from as far away as Pennsylvania.

If you ask Ciolino if he has a favorite tractor, he says no. Ciolino says he is partial to the International Harvester line only because he prefers the look of a red tractor over a green one. It's as simple as that.

Ciolino has considered opening up a museum of sorts and has even had a school group visit his property to check out his collection, but he says he doesn't *See Tractors, continued on page 20*

Caddo Parish man arrested for timber theft

A Greenwood man was arrested Aug. 14, 2013 by Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) enforcement agents and charged with three counts of timber theft Wednesday morning.

Sixty-one year old David Lubas of 7500 Waterwood Drive, Greenwood, La., was arrested and booked into the Desoto Parish jail in Mansfield and charged with three

counts of felony timber theft valued at approximately \$152,000.

"This arrest was the result of a six-month long investigation in which LDAF investigators found that Lubas, who was working as a consultant forester for a Desoto parish landowner in 2009, failed to give load tickets for timber harvested off the property to the landowner. This resulted in the landowner being shorted approximately \$68,000.

LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain said, "We urge all landowners to be vigilant when it comes to who is on their property and any ongoing activity, especially when it comes to timber harvesting."

In addition, Lubas allegedly had a logging contractor issue him four checks between 2010 and 2011 claiming the money was his commission for services rendered to the landowner. Lubas received nearly

\$84,000 from these payments. Lubas reportedly collected a 40 percent commission instead of the standard 10 percent commission that was originally agreed upon with the landowner.

After receiving the 40 percent commission fee from the logging contractor, investigators say Lubas presented his bill for services to the landowner and was paid an additional 10 percent.

It's The Law -- No One is Exempt!

The beef check-off law goes into effect every time cattle are sold. This includes purebred sales and private treaty sales on the farm. The law requires that you must collect the national, plus the 50 cents state check-off money during your sale. The 50 cents state check-off is now a Mandatory Collection as a result of Act 298 passed in the 1995 Louisiana legislature, but producers may request a refund of this amount only, by written request to the Louisiana Beef Industry Council.

The seller is also responsible under the law. The seller may collect and remit the \$1.50 per head in a private treaty transaction. This is the best way to handle purebred sales. To avoid a late payment charge, money must be remitted by the 15th of the month following the sale. Penalties of up to \$5,000 per transaction applies to violators. All sale transactions are subject to audit to insure compliance with the check-off law.

know if the kids really realized the history behind what they were looking at.

Ciolino says he believes there will always be people who will collect older tractors just because they've evolved so much over the years. "While there's something to be said about the newer tractors which bring comfort, efficiency, reliability, and simplicity to operate; with the older tractors, sometimes you just need a wrench or a screw driver and you can fix whatever problem it has," said Ciolino. For farmers, that in itself saves on downtime because with the newer models, a dealer has to come out and fix it because of the technology. "The new technology is great, but I love the simplicity of older tractors." On the other hand, he adds, "Driving on an iron wheel tractor with an iron seat, you really appreciate the comfort of modern equipment, but back then, you really had something."

He also loves the stories behind old tractors. "After the war, my grandpa had a coupon to get a tractor. At that time, you'd

get a coupon, then you'd have to find a dealership that actually had a tractor to sell. He found a tractor in Simmesport and it took him two days to drive it back to Hammond." Ciolino still has the 1953 John Deere tractor that his grandfather bought brand new in 1953. It even came with a pedal tractor for a child. Ciolino has that too.

Over the years, he's picked up a few classic cars, trucks, even a 1917 American La France fire truck along the way. "Some of the older vehicles I've bought have been part of the tractor deal."

Another passion – wait for it – yes, it has to do with tractors – is quarter scale tractor pulls and diesel pulls. "It's fun to have the bragging rights when you win." He mostly competes in Tennessee and up north where tractor pulling is a sport for them during the winter.

But that pastime doesn't surpass his love of collecting old tractors and restoring them. "It's a feeling of accomplishment when you can get an old tractor running."

La. 4-H'ers learn about science, technology at camp

POLLOCK, La. – 4-H'ers at Camp Grant Walker learned about outdoor skills and science on Aug. 5-9 with a program aimed at getting seventh- and eighth-graders interested in science and the outdoors.

For Byron Berrios, of New Orleans, the week had been just what he wanted. "I wish I could stay here for weeks," he said

after his turn at shooting a rifle. "It's like school, but better."

The week has two different curricula – Science, Engineering and Technology, or SET, and Louisiana Outdoor Science and Technology, called LOST.

David Boldt, LSU AgCenter instructor for science, engineering and shooting sports, said the SET program was started

with the goal of keeping 4-H students interested after the sixth grade and to interest students in science and technology. "It's career focused," he said. "Every track in SET has a career focus."

Forensic science had the attention of Faith Gonzales, of St. Bernard Parish. After all, she's a fan of the forensic television shows, and she wants to be a private investigator.

"I watch them all the time," she said of the television shows. "I have to watch them until the end, or I'll be freaked out."

Gonzales was learning about the science of blood spatters, using red-dyed water. But she also enjoyed a class called Hillbilly Jam that used pots, pans and garbage cans to make a percussion band. "I can't make that much noise at my house."

Over at the Hillbilly Jam, Kirsten Maze, of Abbeville, banged out a syncopated rhythm in perfect time. She was a natural because she plays clarinet in her school band.

Hayden McBride, of Iota, said the Hillbilly Jam was his favorite thing during the week. "I like the rhythm. I just get to make music with buckets."

The LOST curriculum also has traditional camp activities, such as canoeing and archery along with riflery and skeet shooting. And plenty of time is available for swimming in the nearby creek or the swimming pool.

In the video class, Maddie Bordelon, of Plaquemine, was making a film – a remake of "The Little Rascals" – with

Lauryn Wilkerson, of Vermilion Parish. Bordelon said it was the first time she had ever made a film, but she seemed to have found her niche.

"I have been told I'm pretty good with a camera," she said. "And I love to write stories."

In the kitchen, 4-H'ers were learning the science of cooking. Dishes they prepared were designed to teach them about how different ingredients react when heated or stirred or mixed with other things. The youth were learning the science of manipulating proteins to make soufflés, flan, pudding, cake and meringue – all with no mixes.

"We're doing everything with eggs today," explained instructor Helen Page, LSU AgCenter 4-H agent from Calcasieu Parish.

Bruce Johnson, of Arcadia, a wetlands instructor for the LOST classes, was in his 10th week at the camp, and his enthusiasm was evident. "I just like working with the kids most of all."

The SET and LOST classes had a competition going. Every day, students crafted small boats. The SET class used modern materials while the LOST class relied on sticks bound with string. The boats raced on a small stretch of the creek that snakes behind the camp.

David Rhodes, of Union Parish, was proud of his boat, a sailboat with an outrigger, even though it came in second place. "It's named the USS Cheddar because people call me Cheddar, and I built it."
