## Strain named NASDA secretary-treasurer

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., has been elected by members of the National Association of States Department of Agriculture (NASDA) to serve as secretary-treasurer for the year 2014.

"It is an honor to be selected as one of 10 board of directors representing the United States farmers and related industries. As secretary-treasurer, Louisiana will have a great impact on issues at the national level," said Strain.

NASDA's mission is to represent the state departments of agriculture in the development, implementation, and communication of policy and programs which support and promote the American agricultural industry while protecting consumers and the environment.

"This is a very important time in agriculture – from food safety and food security issues to getting the Farm Bill passed – I look forward to helping promote and advance this important industry," added Strain.

Strain recently served as president of SUSTA (the Southern United States Trade Association), president of SASDA (the Southern Association of State Departments of Agriculture), and remains chair of the Animal and Plant Industries Committee of NASDA.

Strain is on track to becoming president of NASDA in 2017.

Over at Kleinpeter Farms Dairy, even the cows have health benefits. The 100-year-old business which is known for receiving perfect scores over the past few years from the American Humane Association, is now using a new ultrasound technology on its pregnant cows who are on their way to becoming new moms.

The goal of the ultrasound technology is to diagnose and prevent problems in cow pregnancies. The portable machine can also detect pregnancy between 15 and 30 days sooner than manual checks.

Why is this technology important? "Through early detection the use of the ultrasound machine saved the lives of 45-50 cows. Considering the cost of treatment when a cow gets sick, because we

give them the best medical care possible, we've saved, just in the last year, more than \$100,000 in the value of lost cows and the treatment for them and the ones we are able to save. That is more than the cost of the machine, which cost \$12,500. Not only do we save the lives of our precious 'girls', but we also pass the savings along to Kleinpeter customers," said Jeff Kleinpeter, President, Kleinpeter Farms Dairy.

This wellness benefit program is available to all

1,200 bovine employees located at the St. Helena Parish dairy farm. They are, of course, considered full-time employees.

The portable technology allows the cows to be checked in their stalls. Cow ultrasounds are more accurate than manual checks and by using the tool, time is not wasted trying to inseminate a cow if she is already pregnant.

Artificial insemination is the method used first to try to impregnate a cow. It's safer for the cow because it doesn't involve direct contact with the bull. However, if it doesn't work, bulls are used. With the ultrasound, the dairy knows earlier if the cow is pregnant which saves unnecessary exposure to a bull in which the cow can be injured during

breeding.

"We're just trying to work more efficiently while maintaining and even improving the health of our cows. It's all about taking things to the next level. Our cows do an important job and they deserve to be treated well," added Kleinpeter.

Kleinpeter Farms Dairy is the only dairy farm in Louisiana using the UMS900, from Universal Imaging.

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## Strain responds to EPA withdrawal of data collection proposal

Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., says the withdrawal of a proposal that allowed the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to collect basic and private information from farming operations across the country is a victory for Louisiana farmers. The EPA was seeking the information under the Clean Water Act Section 308, but was adamantly opposed by the agricultural industry. However, the move to not pursue the proposal has reportedly prompted a lawsuit

by community, animal welfare and environmental organizations. “We recently reached out to the EPA and explained that Louisiana agriculture and forestry has been extremely proactive in addressing water quality concerns. Scientifically based best management practices (BMPs) have been developed and are currently being implemented through the Louisiana Master Farmer Program. The Louisiana Master Farmer Program is rooted in state law and backed by sound science making it a critical component for Louisiana’s overall

water resource management programs,” said Strain.

Strain says much of the data that would be collected by the EPA is confidential and could present a domestic security risk. He adds that he has concerns for the privacy and safety of agricultural producers throughout the United States.

“The mission of the Department of Agriculture and Forestry is to promote, protect and advance agriculture and forestry, and soil and water resources. We feel Louisiana should be allowed to exercise the authority of the Clean Water Act to

develop its own water quality standards and implement them through an EPA approved process which is governed by existing law. These decisions should be based on good science, efforts should be sensitive to economic costs to producers, and consideration should be given to the overall economic impact of farm-based communities,” added Strain.

The original intent of the Clean Water Act was to establish a framework in which the state’s and federal government work together to protect the nation’s waters.

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# LSU and LSU AgCenter dairy programs to consolidate

The LSU AgCenter and the LSU College of Agriculture will be consolidating dairy science programs over the next nine months to expand and better integrate the research, extension and teaching efforts.

"This will be one of the first steps we take as we consolidate administratively the AgCenter and the College of Agriculture," said Bill Richardson, LSU vice president of agriculture. "Our dairy industry in the state, although smaller than it has been in the past, remains a vital part of the Louisiana economy and needs the full support of the academic, research and extension programs."

There are 137 dairy farms in Louisiana, which is down from 375 dairy farms in 2002. The total value of Louisiana milk production in 2012 was \$118 million, according to the

LSU AgCenter's Ag Summary.

Most of the AgCenter's research and extension programs are based out of the Southeast Research Station in Franklinton, La., which includes a state-of-the-art dairy farm with about 190 milking cows.

The LSU College of Agriculture also has a dairy farm with about 90 milking cows. Over the next nine months, these cows will be moved to the Southeast Research Station, which will bring the total number of milking cows there to about 280.

"A larger-scale dairy will allow us to expand our research program. We'll be able to do more projects and projects that require greater numbers of animals," said Phil Elzer, LSU AgCenter associate vice chancellor and program leader for animal sciences.

"A bigger dairy will also offer more opportunities for the teaching program," said Gary Hay, director of the School of Animal Sciences.

Hay said the college will now be able to offer summer internships working at the dairy. Classes from both the college and the School of Veterinary Medicine will make field trips to the dairy and conduct educational activities that require a large-scale dairy.

A small herd of 30 to 50 dairy heifers will remain at the dairy facilities on the LSU campus and will also be used in the teaching program in the College of Agriculture, Hay said.

"We will continue with our popular community programs, such as our annual Farm Day for local schools," Elzer said.

Every spring, the LSU Dairy Science Club, which includes students in the School of Animal Sciences, hosts a Farm Day that attracts about 1,000 students from local elementary schools.

"We bring in animals for this and offer a petting zoo and a chance to milk a cow and learn about farm animals," said Cathleen Williams, dairy science professor and club advisor.

Another change that will be made over the next nine months is moving the Forage Quality Laboratory from the Southeast Station to campus to be part of an expanded facility combined with the Soil Testing & Plant Analysis Lab, Elzer said.

"We will be purchasing new analytical equipment that will broaden the types of testing we do," he said.

The Forage Lab provides feed and

forage analysis for Louisiana and Mississippi forage and livestock producers. Accurate feed analyses allow for diets more precisely balanced to meet animal requirements, which in turn improves animal performance and increases profitability for dairy and livestock producers.

The expanded lab will provide more opportunities for students to get hands-on analytical experience, Elzer said.

The milk produced at the expanded dairy farm in Franklinton will be trucked to the creamery on campus and will allow for expansion of the LSU AgCenter Dairy Store, which is part of the School of Animal Sciences.

"We will offer more products and expand our marketing efforts," Hay said.

## Louisiana part of multistate study to test arsenic in rice growing

Dustin Harrell, LSU AgCenter agronomist at the Rice Research Station here, is participating in a multistate study on arsenic in rice to determine if levels of the element are higher in different varieties and to see if varied flooding methods affect arsenic content.

"Can we change the water management practices to alter the uptake and accumulation of arsenic in rice? That's what we are investigating," Harrell said.

All plants naturally absorb arsenic from the soil, but rice tends to absorb more because it is growing in a flooded, anaerobic condition. This makes arsenic more available for uptake by the plant, he said.

The different flooding regimes being used include:

- The traditional drill-seeded, delayed-flood management practice, where a flood is applied after the rice reaches the three-to-four-leaf stage of development and is left until two weeks before harvest.
- Intermittent flooding, where the initial flood is held for two to three weeks, then allowing the flood to evaporate until mud is exposed, followed by pumping water to a 2-4-inch depth.
- Semi-aerobic rice management, where flushing is conducted regularly, but aerobic conditions are allowed to persist.
- Straight-head management, where the rice is flooded

for 10 days to two weeks followed by draining until the soil cracks, followed by re-flooding until draining for harvest.

The testing is being conducted in all rice-growing states, including Texas, California, Mississippi, Arkansas, Missouri and Louisiana.

Harrell said the flooding practices that allow the field to drain will require more weed management, which will increase herbicide expenses and disease pressure and reduce grain yield.

Varieties being tested are CL151, Cheniere, Presidio and Jupiter - along with hybrids CLXL729 and CLXL745.

Harrell said all rice samples will be milled at the Rice Research Station and then sent to a lab for determining inorganic and organic arsenic content. He said results should be available by the spring of 2014.

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration has recently reported the results of testing and concluded that there are no health issues associated with arsenic in rice and rice products.

"This study is simply long-term research to allow Louisiana rice producers to produce the safest, most nutritious rice available for our customers," said Steve Linscombe, director of the Rice Research Station.
