29 new La. Master Farmers recognized

The 2014 graduates of the Louisiana Master Farmer Program were recognized at the 68th Annual Meeting of the Louisiana Soil and Water Conservation Districts Jan. 9 in Lafayette.

A total of 29 newly certified Master Farmers received their certifications at the event.

"You have created a masterpiece of conservation," said Kevin Norton, state conservationist with the Natural Resources Conservation Service. "This is to acknowledge the great work you have done."

Norton said the Master Farmer designation indicates these producers are responsible stewards of the environment.

The voluntary, incentive-based Master Farmer Program should help convince regulatory agencies that Louisiana producers are doing their best to maintain clean air, water and soil, he said.

The entire board of the Vermilion Parish Soil and Water Conservation District is now Master Farmers, and many NRCS employees have become certified, demonstrating that they recognize the significance of the program.

One NRCS employee, Larry Sayes, of Avoyelles Parish, was chosen as Outstanding Master Farmer after the new Master Farmers were recognized.

Bill Richardson, LSU vice president for agriculture, said the Master Farmer partnership – the LSU AgCenter, the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry, the Louisiana Farm Bureau and the Louisiana Cattlemen's Association – will be important to address potential regulatory issues facing Louisiana agriculture.

"It's nice to work in a state where everyone is working on the same page."

Mike Strain, LDAF commissioner, said Louisiana has led the nation by developing the Master Farmer Program. "Louisiana is truly a pioneer in this respect."

The Master Rice Grower Program, developed with the Kellogg Co. to reward rice farmers for their conservation practices, could be expanded to other commodities, he said.

Strain was among the 29 individuals recognized for completing the requirements of the Louisiana Master Farmer Program.

USDA Designates Drought Disaster Areas

Baton Rouge, La. - Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., received notice Jan. 15 from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) that three Louisiana

parishes contiguous to Arkansas are now designated natural disaster areas as a result of a recent drought.

The three parishes named as contiguous disaster areas are: Claiborne, Morehouse and

Union.

A federal disaster designation makes farm operators in primary and contiguous areas eligible to be considered for certain assistance from the Farm Service Agency (FSA), provided eligibil-

ity requirements are met. This assistance includes low-interest FSA emergency loans.

USDA NRCS extends sign-up period for Conservation Stewardship Program

The sign-up period ends February 7, 2014

Alexandria, January 15, 2014 -The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) has extended the deadline for accepting applications for fiscal year 2014 enrollments in the Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP). Producers interested in participating in the program must visit their local NRCS office and apply by February 7, 2014.

"Extending the sign-up period to February 7th allows time for more farmers, ranchers and forest landowners to apply for CSP," said State Conservationist Kevin Norton. "CSP is a popular program in Louisiana. Since it began, over 900,000 acres of land have been enrolled in the program across the state."

Lands eligible for the Conservation Stewardship Program include cropland, pas-

tureland, rangeland, nonindustrial private forest land, and agricultural land under the jurisdiction of an American Indian tribe. While local NRCS offices accept CSP applications year round, NRCS evaluates applications during announced ranking periods. To be eligible for this year's enrollment, producers must have their applications submitted to NRCS by February 7, 2014.

A CSP self-screening checklist is available to help potential applicants determine if CSP is suitable for their operation. The checklist highlights basic information about CSP eligibility requirements, contract obligations, and potential payments. It is available from local NRCS offices and on the CSP web page at: www.nrcs.usda.gov/wps/portal/nrcs/main/national/programs/financial/csp/.

Easy Louisiana duck egg Quiche

1 pie shell	1/4 cup rendered bacon
5 duck eggs beaten	1 teaspoon salt
1/4 cup shredded artisan cheese	1t Chef Celeste's Italian season blend

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Combine all ingredients and pour into the shell. Bake for 15 min then, reduce heat to 300 degrees. Bake an additional 30 minutes then remove from oven, let the Quiche rest for 10 min then serve.

Sweet potato/ squash soup

4 tbsps. butter	1 large squash peeled, seeded and diced
3 sweet potatoes peeled and diced	40 oz chicken stock
1 large carrot diced	1 tsp. salt

Combine onion, peppers, tomato, oil, broccoli and rosemary, Add lime juice and salt. Slice meat thin and place on a bed of lettuce, top with tomato mixture.

Fatal palm disease detected in New Orleans

The fatal disease Texas Phoenix palm decline, also known as date palm lethal decline, has been positively confirmed on Canary Island date palms in New Orleans, according to LSU AgCenter plant doctor Raj Singh.

"Until recently, the disease has only been found in Florida and Texas," Singh said.

The disease got its name from Texas, where it was first identified on Phoenix canarensis or Canary Island date palm in 2001.

It is a fatal disease that rapidly causes decline and kills the infected palms, he said.

The pathogen is known to cause decline in Canary Island date palm, edible date palm, silver date palm, wild date palm, cabbage palm and queen palm, said LSU AgCenter horticulturist Andrew Loyd.

"The pathogen colonizes in the phloem tissue from where it spreads systemically to new plant parts," Loyd said.

Scientists suspect the disease is spread by sap-feeding insects with piercing-sucking mouthparts, such as plant hoppers, psyllids or tree hoppers, Loyd said. However, the exact species of the insect vector is unknown.

Symptoms of the disease start with discoloration of tips of the oldest leaves. Infected leaves then turn reddish brown to dark brown and eventually die.

Palms infected with this disease exhibit a large proportion of discolored leaves in the lower region of the canopy, Singh said. The spear leaf dies and turns tan colored after approximately one-third of the lower leaves have discolored.

"Infection on mature palms leads to premature drop of majority of fruits in a few days," Singh said. "Root rot may also occur in infected palms."

Management of Texas Phoenix palm decline in infected palms is not possible, Singh said.

"Symptomatic palms with dead spear leaves must be removed immediately, because they may serve as a source of the pathogen for the insect vectors to transmit the disease to healthy, susceptible palms," he said.

Successful disease management in landscape where the disease is prevalent can be achieved by preventative treatment of healthy, susceptible palms with antibiotic oxytetracycline hydrochloride, Singh said.

The antibiotic should be administered as a trunk injection every three to four months, he said. Accurate identification of this disease in the field is required for effective disease management.

Other diseases and disorders of palms may produce similar symptoms, which can make it hard to identify the disease based solely on symptoms.

"Samples from suspected palms can be submitted to the LSU

AgCenter Plant Diagnostic Center for positive identification. But before anyone collects any samples, they should contact us," Singh said.

Recent cold snap sets back strawberry crop

Recent cold weather caused a slowdown in strawberry production, and that will delay some of the sales that growers were hoping for.

Before the recent cold snap, farmers were harvesting from the plug plants they planted in September and were about ready to start harvesting from the bare-rooted plants that were planted in mid-October, according to Sandra Benjamin, LSU AgCenter agent in Tangipahoa Parish.

"All the blooms and green fruit on the bare-rooted plants were lost due to the freeze," Benjamin said. Most farmers had been harvesting from their plug plants, which have been producing berries since November.

Plants had been covered most of December, Benjamin said.

The row covers growers used to protect their crop don't hurt the plants, but they do allow mold to grow because they are in a

greenhouse-type situation," said Ponchatoula-area grower Eric Morrow.

"This has been some of the coldest weather that we have seen in years," Morrow said. "Anytime the weather is in the 30s, we have to cover, and that has been the case most of the month of December."

The cold weather won't kill the plants, Morrow said, but it slows things down so growers won't have the berries they would like to have this month.

"Strawberry plants are really, really tough," he said. "The cold weather actually reinvigorates them, and they'll come on with a vengeance. In late March and April we ought to have plenty of berries."

Benjamin said last year growers had a wet winter, especially in December, which caused a lot of plants to die.

"Too much water causing no oxygen in the root system was one problem," she said.

"Rows collapsed and plants just did not grow as well, which caused the production to be down."

Benjamin said growers would prefer cold and freezing temperatures anytime instead of continuous rain.

About 20 commercial strawberry farmers are in the state, and about 25 home gardeners grow strawberries in Tangipahoa Parish, Benjamin said.

"The commercial growers cut down on acreage this year, so there are about 285 total acres of strawberries planted in Tangipahoa Parish," Benjamin said. "Last season there were about 350 acres."

The reduction in acreage is due to the loss of last year's production, she said.

"We are not losing strawberry growers, but we're not gaining any new growers either," she said. "The largest operation is about 80 acres, and the others are from one to 20 acres."
