“You have families that were in the cattle business but no longer. However, the brand is almost like a coat of arms,” said Carl Bennett, director of the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Livestock Brand Commission.

Originally, brands were used to identify property. “With all the men fighting during WWII, cattle theft was markedly increased. Today, brand inspection laws mean livestock cannot be sold at public sale and in some states cannot be moved from one state to another without being inspected by an

brands now: one establishes ownership and one that a cattle producer uses to reference and document inventory.

To apply for a brand, contact the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) at 225-925-3962.

“It’s a known fact that cattle thieves avoid branded cattle. An amateur might do it without knowing but those cattle are hard to sell without being called into question,” added Bennett.

The LDAF registers brands and marks for cows, equine, sheep, dogs and hogs.

## South Louisiana doctor pens book about early pioneer families in Terrebonne Parish

What started as a labor of love for Houma native Dr. Chris Cenac, Sr. has turned into more than a family chronicle of history. His research has led to the emergence of the history of a community with strong ties to agriculture.

“When you think of Terrebonne Parish, you think of fishing, seafood and oil fields, but every pioneer family had cattle,” said Cenac. And that’s how this story begins. Cenac says he learned some years back from his father that Cenac’s great-grandfather, Jean-Pierre Cenac, had a brand registered in the 1860s. He went to the courthouse to find the records, but no one knew what he was talking about.


“Remarkably, two years later I received a call and was told they thought they found what I was looking for.”

What they found were the three *Brand Books of Terrebonne, 1822-1946*, which had been collecting dust in a parish storage facility. The brand books were complete. What a discovery!

Cenac says locating the Terrebonne Parish brand registry opened up a treasure chest of history. “In the brand books, I found the two oldest European ancestors in my family,” said Cenac. But that wasn’t all he found. The Cenac family is one of the earliest settlers that pre-date Terrebonne becoming a parish in 1822. At the time, residents had to register their brands and marks. Carl Bennett, director of the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry Livestock Brand Commission, said before 1944, brands were registered on a parish by parish basis.

“The brand books documented the chronological settling of the parish from its creation in 1822 because we had the only complete set of brand books in the state,” said Cenac.

The book Cenac is referencing is *Livestock Brands and Marks: An Unexpected Bayou Country History*



which was published in 2013. Cenac worked on that book simultaneously as he also wrote *Eyes of an Eagle*, a book about his great-grandfather and the history of Terrebonne which was published two years earlier. Cenac says it is the only documented history of life on the southeast coast of Louisiana from the civil war to the 1920s. “Between the two books, I tell the whole history of the community and the establishment of the parish.”

Cenac was able to document the history because he reads and

speaks French and many of the records were in both French and English. He also did all of the research himself with some guidance from archivists, historians and other published authors. “I wanted to do it right and once I started, it kept growing.”

Cenac, who is an orthopedic surgeon by profession, says he never intended to be a book author. He just wanted to document his family’s history for his grandchildren so they knew where they came from and how their family contributed to Terrebonne Parish. “I didn’t do any of this on purpose, but what we’ve done is preserve history for more than just our family. It’s a history lesson.”

Cenac says the most amazing things have happened since writing these two books. “I’ve had people call and write me to say I have found my ancestors because of this book. It’s been beneficial in multiple ways.

“We had a book signing and a woman came to me asking about her grandfather’s brand. I showed her his brand registration, number 575, January 11, 1878. She said she brought my book to the courthouse and the information in the book helped prove that her family had land. She told me that it proved to her family they also contributed to this parish.”

While Cenac’s father was a surgeon and many in

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## LDAF forestry grant program underway

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is accepting applications for the 2013 Urban & Community Forestry Grant (U&CF) program.

For the 2013 program year, \$98,000 in federal money is available. These funds will be distributed through a competitive grants allocation process in which the LDAF will award the grants.

"It is so important that we protect our natural resources such as our forests. One of Louisiana's major commodities is forestry which at last report was valued at \$3 billion," said LDAF Commissioner Mike Strain,

These matching fund grants are for activities not currently being funded and are not intended to substitute for existing funding levels.

In order to meet objectives outlined in the National Urban Forestry Guidelines and the Louisiana Urban Forestry Council's Strategic Plan for Louisiana Community Forestry, this program is geared toward establishing and/or strengthening existing community forestry programs in Louisiana.

National direction has become more focused during the past years. Specific community forestry capaci-

ty building activities being promoted includes the following:

- 1) Employment of professional urban forestry staff at the community level;
- 2) Development of community forestry management plans based on resource assessments/inventories;
- 3) Development or strengthening of community forestry ordinances and policy; and
- 4) Development or enhancement of local advocacy/advisory organizations.

The Forest Service (USFS) has also placed emphasis on the (5) five national U&CF programs goals:

- 1) Minimize the impact on land use change and urbanization on forests;
- 2) Minimize the risk and impact of catastrophic events;
- 3) Protect and improve air and water quality;
- 4) Mitigate climate change;
- 5) Energy Conservation.

The LDAF must report specific activities to the USFS each year, and future funding is based upon the number of communities participating in the activities.

# Annual LDAF shade tree sale dates set

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) will hold its annual shade tree sale on various dates throughout the state, Commissioner Mike Strain, D.V.M., said.



“Consumers know they’ll be able to purchase a variety of hardwood and pine seedlings that are descended from superior stock,” Strain said. “Since the seedlings can be purchased in small packets they are manageable for just about any home gardener.”

Two types of seedling packets will be offered.

Pine packets contain 20 loblolly or slash seedlings. Hardwood seedling packets contain six seedlings including two bald

cypress, river birch, green ash, shumard oak and red maple. Both pine and hardwood packets are priced at \$6 each.

Packet species content may vary in some cases, depending on availability.

All seedlings are bare-root and come with planting and care instructions. They will be available on a first-come basis and cannot be reserved in advance.

“Some years we sell out of certain species before the week is out, especially some of the hardwoods, so we encourage folks to come early during the sale,” Strain said.

## Freeze effects to state's agriculture are minimal

BATON ROUGE, La. – A winter storm that blanketed most of Louisiana in snow and ice, shutting down schools and businesses, didn't cause much damage to the state's agriculture.

Kurt Guidry, an LSU AgCenter economist, conducted a survey of major commodities.

“Fortunately, it looks like from a statewide perspective, the effects will be fairly minimal. However, like with any adverse weather situation, there are individual producers and commodities that are impacted,” Guidry said.

Strawberry farmers are seeing the most injury to their crop. As temperatures started to rise on Thursday, Ponchatoula farmer, Eric Morrow, pulled back the row covers that protect his crop to survey the damage.

“We probably got a few red berries that we saved and some green fruit, but we lost all the flowers that we had,” Morrow said.

It takes anywhere from 21 to 35 days for new flowers to set fruit, so Morrow said it will be the middle of March before he has a good crop of strawberries.

“The season will be delayed,” he said. “We’ll have a lot of berries for our traditional March and April season.”

Regina Bracy, director of the LSU AgCenter's Hammond Research Station, said the winter has been so cold that farmers have had to keep their strawberries mostly covered, uncovering them only to pick and spray.

“The crop is going to be more expensive to produce because farmers have to provide so much cold protection,” Bracy said.

Also, the inability to sell strawberries early in the season when prices are typically highest could affect the overall average price that producers receive for their crop.

Guidry said crawfish farmers are reporting that the catch will be delayed, but the freeze did not result in any mortality.

He also said a few newborn calves were killed by the freezes, but numbers were not excessive, and poultry producers are experiencing increased energy costs this year to help keep their poultry houses warm.

Guidry said cattle farmers will likely face bigger challenges from reduced forage production.

“This will likely cause producers to have to incur additional feed and hay costs as they try to offset lower forage production,” Guidry said.

Ed Twidwell, a pasture and forage crop specialist, with the LSU AgCenter said this has not been a good year for either ryegrass or small grain pastures, but he is optimistic.

“We are still pretty early in the grazing season and the ryegrass and forage crops can recover and produce a great deal of grazing during the spring,” Twidwell said.

LSU AgCenter's wheat specialist, Josh

Lofton, said he has seen a good deal of leaf burning on the state's wheat crop, but he believes the damage is superficial and should not impact yields.

The state's citrus harvest was nearly complete when the storm hit, but Guidry reported there could be minor damage on trees, particularly on young trees, and that could affect production for the next harvest.

Most nursery crop growers took precautions and covered vulnerable plants, so widespread damage and plant death is not expected. But Guidry said the costs involved with protecting plants are going to raise growers' production costs. Heating greenhouses and covering plants add to fuel and labor costs.

Nursery owners also are seeing a drop in sales as demand has turned cold along with the temperatures, but it could pick up in spring as homeowners look to replace lost plant material.

“All in all, the state's agricultural industry likely dodged a bullet from this latest adverse weather event,” Guidry said. “There could be some positives that come from the cold temperatures.”

For most of the state's major row crops, the cold temperatures may have reduced the populations of insects and disease, lowering the amount of pest pressure crops see later this spring.
