La. Hall of Distinction honors industry leaders

Service to forestry and farming was recognized recently as three giants in the industries were inducted into the Louisiana Agriculture Hall of Distinction at a banquet held at White Oak Plantation in Baton Rouge.

This year's inductees included Dennis R. Aucoin Sr. of Clinton, Clarence Berken of Lake Arthur and Ellis S. Martin (posthumously) of Alexandria.

Aucoin was inducted for his work in forestry. As owner of Slaughter Logging, his expertise with logging techniques and resource management has made him an industry leader. He is also a Louisiana Loggers Hall of Fame inductee.

Berken has emerged as an agricultural leader with contributions in the rice, soybean and wheat farming industries. He serves as president of the La. Rice Council and he served two terms as president of the La. Rice Growers Association.

Ellis S. Martin is remembered as a mentor in

Louisiana forestry. His presidencies at Martin Timber Co. and Roy O. Martin Lumber Co. brought numerous opportunities to the state, including North America's largest plywood-manufacturing facility.

The Hall of Distinction honors outstanding contributions to Louisiana agriculture in farming, ranching, forestry, aquaculture, education and agribusiness. It is presented by Louisiana Radio Network in conjunction with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry and the LSU AgCenter. Monsanto was the title sponsor and First South Farm Credit was the presenting sponsor.

Founded in 1974 and celebrating its 40th anniversary this year, Louisiana Radio Network provides more than 60 radio stations throughout Louisiana and parts of Mississippi with news, sports and ag-news. LRN also publishes Tiger Rag, "The Bible of LSU Sports" since 1978, and presents the Louisiana Agriculture Hall of Distinction award.

Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

La. granted bird repellent for rice seed by EPA

On February 20, 2014, EPA granted a Section 18 for the authorization of AV-1011 for rice seed. The purpose of this product is to repel blackbirds and reduced-seedling damage in south Louisiana for rice production.

The product, AV-1011 Bird Repellent for Rice Seed is manufactured by Arkion Life Sciences. AV-1011 may be applied directly to the rice seed. The use of this

product is limited to the following parishes: Acadia, Allen, Avoyelles, Beauregard, Calcasieu, Cameron, Evangeline, Jefferson Davis, St. Landry, St. Martin and Vermillion.

In the past, Louisiana rice producers have suffered yield losses that range from 50-90 percent without the use of AV-1011. Producers can spend as much as \$100 per acre for alternative meth-

ods to repel the blackbirds.

The timing of approval from EPA was critical because seed dealers and producers are in the process of preparing seed and land at the present for the beginning of this year's rice crop. The approval of AV-1011 will allow producers to better plan for planting, choosing either "water seeding or dry seeding" depending on their situa-

The Blackbirds typically migrate to the south to overwinter. Once the rice crops are planted the blackbirds move into these areas and eat "holes" in the fields. As these "holes" are recognized, producers are faced with the decision of replanting or leaving the "holes." Both constitute loss, due to timing of replanting, added cost or loss of seedlings to produce rice.

All non-virgin bulls and bulls older than 24 months for sale in Louisiana must have a current negative trichomoniasis test from an accredited veterinarian before they may be sold. Virgin bulls must have a breeder's certification of virgin status signed by the breeder, the breeder's agent or an accredited veterinarian. New food safety rules still being developed

BATON ROUGE, La. - Although Congress passed the Food Safety Modernization Act in 2010, the Food and Drug Administration is still in the process of developing rules to enforce the law. The rules seek to enhance safety regulations by requiring more documentation and shifting the focus to prevention rather than response.

Complying with these new rules could be especially challenging for farmers and other food producers with limited financial resources, said LSU AgCenter extension food safety specialist Achyut Adhikari. Proposed FSMA rules touch every aspect of agriculture operations, including water and biological soil amendment quality, workers' hygiene, wild animal control and equipment storage.

Adhikari, who joined the AgCenter in February, is developing food safety educational outreach programs that will help producers implement food safety practices and satisfy updated requirements. Meeting and maintaining the level of water quality proposed by FSMA will be

an important issue in Louisiana, he said.

One proposed FSMA rule states that if E. coli is detectable in surface water, growers are prohibited from using that water during or after harvest of produce that is consumed raw. E. coli can be used as an indicator of pathogens that are difficult to test for, Adhikari said.

Testing for E. coli, however, is time-consuming and expensive. Adhikari said if a farmer suspects runoff is contaminating surface water, he or she must test that water every seven days. Still, producers can never have total control over their water supply.

"In Louisiana, we have a lot of rain," Adhikari said. "Because of the rain, the water will carry contaminants from the soil to the surface water. In such occasions, alternatives can be taken, including changing the irrigation system or treating the water."

FSMA also permits producers to treat their water, but the FDA has not yet specified approved treatments.

The law will also affect the way some producers use their land. Raw manure is

the main source of several pathogens. If a grower uses raw manure for soil enrichment, he or she must wait nine months after application to harvest the food crop.

This is problematic in Louisiana, Adhikari said, where it is common for farmers to pasture animals in areas where they grow crops such as pecans. It also means producers must take extra precautions against wild animals - if they come in contact with food crops, the producer cannot legally harvest it.

The AgCenter is assembling a food safety task force of experts from various departments that will develop programs for growers. One goal they have is to identify alternative, science-based treatments and practices that reach FSMA-mandated levels of protection but are more appropriate for Louisiana.

Making sure producers understand and comply with FSMA rules is crucial, said Gina E. Eubanks, LSU AgCenter associate vice chancellor and program leader for nutrition and food science.

"In the long run, no farmer wants to produce unsafe food," Eubanks said.

"Sometimes, that costs. It may be an extra step that you have to do when you're processing, or you would have to not use a certain chemical."

There are many steps on the route from farm to fork, Eubanks said, which means there are plenty of opportunities for contamination. While some precautions may prove expensive, taking simple measures such as hand washing can help prevent the spread of foodborne illnesses.

Just as red lights, stop signs and speed limits help prevent automobile accidents, FSMA strives to put regulations in place that prevent food-related accidents, Eubanks said.

Smaller growers are exempt from certain rules because they cannot be held to the same expectations as large farms, Adhikari said.

The FDA is reevaluating its original proposals based on feedback from the public. Adhikari said the revised rules may be more feasible to implement. Even though some will still involve an economic burden, reducing the number of cases of foodborne illnesses is important.

LDAF Volunteer Fire Assistance program now underway

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry (LDAF) is now accepting applications for the 2014 Volunteer Fire Assistance Program (VFA).

The VFA program is funded through the U.S. Forest Service and administered by the LDAF on a 50/50 cost share basis to qualifying fire departments to be used to organize, train and equip fire crews for the prevention and suppression of fires.

Eligibility requirements:

-Any fire department that is based in a community, with a population of 10,000 or less (latest Census), is eligible to apply for funding under the VFA program.

-Departments serving a population greater than 10,000 are eligible to apply if the department is a "multi-community" department, providing no single community served has a population greater than 10,000. A department or fire district is considered to be "multi-community" if within the official area served there exists two or more recognized communities, each of which must contribute financial support toward, and combine other resources for the operation of a single department serving all of the communities involved.

-A single community fire department serving a population greater than 10,000 and NOT providing protection to a rural community is not eligible for VFA financial assistance.

-Fire Departments must be NIMS compliant. NIMS compliance information can be found at <http://www.fema.gov/national-incident-management-system>

Cattle experts give advice at Iberia Station field day

JEANERETTE, La. – More than 150 people attended the 2014 Beef Cattle Producers Annual Spring Field Day held at the LSU AgCenter Iberia Research Station on March 8.

The LSU AgCenter Master Cattle Producer Program recognized 47 graduates at the field day. They underwent more than 30 hours of classroom instruction.

Phil Elzer, LSU AgCenter vice chancellor for animal science programs, told the group that a regional concept is being started to expand the Master Cattle Producer Program statewide. Ryon Walker at the Hill Farm Research Station and Guillermo Scaglia at the Iberia Research Station will be working with county agents in the north, central and eastern parts of the state. Three extension agents will also have beef cattle responsibilities – Vince Deshotel in St. Landry Parish, Jason Holmes in Union Parish and Kenny Sharpe in Livingston Parish.

Mike Strain, commissioner of the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry, said the Master Cattle and Louisiana Master Farmer programs demonstrate the agricultural industry's commitment to environmental stewardship.

During the field tour, Scaglia, beef cattle nutritionist, gave a summary about his experiment evaluating different stocking rates. He is using 3.3-acre paddocks and stocking them with five, six, seven and eight steers weighing an average of 550 pounds.

Scaglia discussed an experiment using heifers grazing ryegrass alone or supplemented with ground corn or soybean hulls. He said the animals get the protein mainly from grass, and the supplements are intended for energy needs. He said 3.5 pounds of supplementary feed per head each day allows the heifers to gain weight well.

Scaglia also told the attendees about his study of two groups, each with 31 Brangus cows. One group is getting all they need in terms of their nutritional requirements and their pastures are well-fertilized, while the other group is managed more extensively.

"We are comparing a high versus low input cow-calf system," he said, adding that the performance and economic evaluation of both groups will be compared.

Karl Harborth, LSU AgCenter livestock specialist, said vitamins and minerals are essential to proper cattle nutrition, and cattle owners should take a proactive approach. "We don't find out we have a problem with our mineral nutrition until it's too late."

He said year-round supplementation can be done, but it's more costly. He said high iron levels in drinking water can interfere with cattle absorbing enough essential elements such as copper.

Harborth said the hard freezes have affected green grasses, so cattle without good grazing will require supplements of Vitamins A and E.

Ed Twidwell, LSU AgCenter forage specialist, said the recent cold weather has given weeds an advantage over grasses, and 2,4-D at a pint per acre can be used to control 80 percent of broadleaf weeds with only 10 percent damage to clovers. Increasing the rate to a quart boosts weed control to 90 percent but it damages 70 percent of clover.

"This is the best time of year to control curly dock and buttercup and not damage your clover," he said.

Other chemicals such as Grazon P+D, Weedmaster and Pasture Guard will control weeds but kill all clover, he said.

He said broomsedge is becoming more of a problem, even in pastures regularly cut for hay.

Smutgrass has become the state's No. 1 pasture weed problem, he said, but it can be controlled with Velpar. However, the chemical is expensive, requires moisture after application, and it can kill nearby trees.

Shannon Gonsoulin, a veterinarian in Iberia Parish, told the crowd about a 10-year study of calving problems. He said continental breeds tend to have more calving difficulties because of their shape and size. "Anything with a Brahman influence is going to be an easier calving if you look at the numbers and percentages."

County agents Stan Dutile of Lafayette Parish and Andrew Granger of Vermilion Parish demonstrated ways of assisting

delivery of a calf with devices to remove the newborn from the birth canal.

The birth process should only take an hour or two, Dutile said, and assistance should not be given unless calving is delayed.

Granger said gentleness is essential to avoid injuring the cow or calf.

Dutile said pregnant cows nearing delivery will show signs before calving by isolating themselves from a herd. Granger said cows regularly fed in late afternoon tend to have daytime births.

Newborn calves should start nursing within 30 minutes, Dutile said, and a colostrum supplement can be used if a calf refuses to nurse.
