A member of the Louisiana Army National Guard (LANG) steps off a boat with a pet carrier, enters a tent and checks in his new four legged pal. It's that time of year when Louisiana braces for the dreaded hurricane season. State and local officials are preparing by participating in training exercises to familiarize themselves with best practices and ensure everyone is on the same page. It's all part of the annual Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP) and LANG hurricane preparedness exercise this past April at the Bonnet Carre' Spillway.

"Those participating in the exercise practice how to stay safe in the boat while traveling with the pets and go through the process of decontamination so people and animals don't have skin issues once they get out of the flood water," said Dr. Renee Poirrier with Louisiana State Animal Response Team (LSART).

Veterinarian from St. Martinville Dr. Jackie Simon is a volunteer with LSART and checks the health of the pet that has been brought to her. "The biggest issues we deal with are containment with animals and that they are safe, have copies of medical records and that pet owners have evacuation kits for their pets."

Simon says those kits are similar to the kits the pet owners should have for themselves. She says they should include: food, bottled water, a sealed container/envelope of some kind to hold important health

records and emergency contacts. The pet kit should also include disposable water/food bowls and cleaning materials. Pet owners should also determine which family members, friends or hotels allow pets prior to needing to evacuate.

The Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry is instrumental in assisting with pet evacuations and operating the state designated pet shelter. Simon added, "The exercise is meant to get state agencies working together. Practice makes things flow more easily when an event occurs."

For people like the ASPCA's Dr. Dick Green who travels the world assisting with disasters and pet rescues, he says Louisiana is ahead of the pack. "There are probably a handful of states that have this type of relationship with the agriculture department. We've had a strong relationship with the ag department and LSART since Hurricane Katrina."

It was in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina that state officials realized that while some people simply ignored the warnings to evacuate, others chose to stay home with their pets because they felt they had nowhere to go that would also accept of the pet. "Last summer, we were in Alaska when there was flooding. The community would not evacuate because they wouldn't leave their pets. Whenever there are people issues, there are pet issues," said Green. It's an all too familiar story when it comes to emergencies and evacuations.

# Louisiana Agriculture & Forestry Today

## Status update on Louisiana's agricultural industry

I begin my morning radio show each day with a statement emphasizing the bright future ahead for Louisiana and American agriculture.

According to the LSU AgCenter, for the second year in a row, Louisiana farmers had record-breaking values for many of their commodities, which led to a new high value of \$11.8 billion for Louisiana's agricultural sector in 2013 – up 3.8 percent from 2012. Over the past 5 years, we have experienced a total growth of over 42 percent.

In addition to strong prices, many commodities saw record yields, such as: cotton 1,221 pounds per acre; corn 186 bushels per acre; sweet potatoes 481 bushels per acre; and rice 7,600 pounds per acre.

The beef cattle industry saw the highest prices in many years up 18 percent from 2013 with a value in excess of \$663 million.

Forestry, our largest plant crop, improved slightly in 2013 to \$2.88 billion.

Further, the 2012 Census of Agriculture has just been released showing key data for Louisiana:

The land in farms dropped by 2.6 percent to 7,900,864 acres while the number of farms dropped by 6.7 percent to 28,093 with an average farm being 281 acres.

In addition, we are aging. In the last 5 years, the average age of the American farmer has risen from 57.1 to 58.5 years of age. Ten years ago the average age was 55.3 years of age

and 35 years ago it was just 50.3 years of age. What do these figures tell us? Fewer and fewer young people are choosing to farm.

On a positive note, this year, the U.S. had a record \$141 billion in agricultural exports with Louisiana contributing more than \$15.75 billion in commodities and products.

In many major publications, including the *Wall Street Journal*, and the next five *National Geographic* issues beginning April 2014, there is a growing focus on both food availability as well as future sustainability.

Our pathway to the future is clear. It is imperative that we double and wherever possible triple production of food and fiber with less inputs per

unit. Growing worldwide demand is driving prices and affecting the availability of seeds and other critical inputs. In order to meet these demands, we must collectively lean forward and embrace new methods and technologies as well as tried and true methods like selective breeding and established scientific protocols.

Each day, we are challenged and often criticized for embracing such technologies as genetic modification or the use of unmanned aerial vehicles. We must openly defend and utilize all emerging science and technology that is productive and safe in order to meet these future demands and garner the benefits of our labor for this and future generations.

Additionally, we must actively

engage the legislative process both in the State Capitol and in Washington D.C. There are many groups struggling to be heard, and it is critical that our voice be recognized as one of progressive reasoning and sound advice.



# USDA secretary announces new report on scientific breakthroughs from USDA in 2013

## ***New USDA discoveries led to 180 new inventions, include flour that prevents weight gain, protections from disease for U.S. troops, turning grass clippings to energy***

WASHINGTON, April 23, 2014 - Agriculture Secretary Tom Vilsack today announced a new report on scientific breakthroughs discovered by USDA researchers that led to new patents and inventions with the potential for commercial application and potential economic growth. Innovations included in the report range from flour made out of chardonnay grape seeds that prevents weight gain to antimicrobial packets that keep food from spoiling, efforts to protect U.S. troops in Iraq from diseases carried by sand flies, new processes for turning grass clippings and raked leaves into bioenergy, and many more.

USDA reports receiving 51 patents, filing 147 patent applications, and disclosing 180 new inventions in the last fiscal year, which are detailed in the department's 2013 Annual Report on Technology Transfer released today. Helping drive these innovations, USDA has 259 active Cooperative Research and Development Agreements with outside investigators, which includes Universities and other organizations, including 117 with small businesses. The

USDA's technology transfer program is administered by the Agricultural Research Service (ARS), USDA's principal intramural scientific research agency.

### **Discoveries from USDA's 2013 Technology Transfer Report include:**

- ◆A new kind of flour made from chardonnay grape seeds that can prevent increases in cholesterol and weight-gain (the Mayo Clinic is currently conducting human clinical trials on the product);

- ◆New ways to turn lawn clippings and tree leaves from cities into bioenergy;

- ◆An enzyme compound that can be used to develop insecticides to combat sand flies, a disease spreading insect that poses a major problem for U.S. military in Iraq and is responsible for hundreds of thousands of childhood deaths in Africa;

- ◆A computer-based model of the fluid milk process to lower greenhouse gas emissions (the model has been distributed to more than 100 processors in the United States and should help the dairy industry realize its goal of reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 25 percent per gallon of milk by 2020);

- ◆Oat concentrates, a digestible, functional food from oats licensed for the production of Calorie-Trim and Nutrim;

- ◆A new process for turning old tires into zinc fertilizer;

- ◆A handheld device that uses gold nanoparticles to detect West Nile virus (and potentially other diseases) in blood samples;

- ◆Window cleaners that use a biodegradable solution of nanoparticles that prevent water-beading that are superior to current cleaners;

- ◆A small packet that when inserted in small fruit containers releases an antimicrobial vapor that helps keep fresh fruit from rotting on the shelf.

Over the years, USDA innovations have created all sorts of products Americans use every day, from cosmetics, to insect controls, leathers, shampoos, and of course food products. Here are just a few examples of things USDA research is responsible for:

- ◆Frozen orange juice concentrate;
- ◆"Permanent press" cotton clothing;
- ◆Mass production of penicillin in World War II;

- ◆Almost all breeds of blueberries and cranberries currently in production, and 80% of all varieties of citrus fruits grown in the U.S.;

- ◆"TifSport" a turf used on NFL, collegiate, and other sports fields across the country, specifically designed to withstand the stress and demands of major team sports. TifSport is also used on PGA and other golf course fairways, while its sister turf, "Tifeagle" specially designed to be mowed to one-tenth of an inch daily, is used on PGA putting greens.

The 2014 Farm Bill will help to build on these accomplishments by establishing a new Foundation for Food and Agriculture Research that leverages \$200 million in public funding and another \$200 million from the private sector to support groundbreaking agricultural research.

Green added this was his fourth exercise in three weeks and there's been no other exercise that has had this type of coordination. He said Louisiana is number one on the pet side.

As for the large animals, there is specific training when it comes to getting them moved and Green says the federal government realizes that large animals must be included in emergency planning. "While we can't take care of every large animal, there needs to be a plan."

It's important for livestock owners who plan to evacuate with a trailer of animals to leave as early as possible. During hurricane evacuations, it is not unusual for routes to close to trailer and towing traffic. Also, be mindful of the heat in the event there is traffic. Those con-

ditions can add stress to your animals – both livestock and pets. Prior to evacuating, tire pressure, rubber tread, brakes, running lights and overall condition of trailer should be checked.

As seen in past emergencies, the Air National Guard, along with the LDAF, the Louisiana Cattlemen's Association and the LSU AgCenter use aerial surveillance to assess the needs of livestock that are affected by disasters. It's dubbed the Rapid Agricultural Assessment in which available resources can be allocated by emergency managers with the data from these assessments. Stranded animals can many times be saved with supplemental feeding and safe drinking water.

Hurricane season starts June 1 and ends November 30.
