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# Building on a small scale

Octogenarian artist Martin Brignac built his first house when he was a boy of 13. The year was 1935. He didn't need to fill out any forms – this was before Social Security, Medicare and FICA – all he needed was his mother's permission.

"There was a fellow in the neighborhood, he was 20 and getting married," Brignac said. "I remember when he came and asked my mama if I could build his house."

The plain frame house, located at the corner of Seneca and Sorrel Streets in the old Standard Heights neighborhood in Baton Rouge, was approximately 22' by 32'.

Nearly 80 years later Brignac remembered that house and built an artistic 20" by 30" three dimensional replica of that home.

It wasn't the first piece of 3-D art Brignac created. He saved that honor for his mother's home.

He pointed to the beautifully colored and detailed rendering of the old-fashioned house hanging on the wall of his present-day Baton Rouge home.



Brignac has magnificently re-created the gray slate roof and single dormer window above the gray-painted porch. A swing hangs under the porch and a tiny sign offering Mrs. Brignac's sewing service is attached to the front porch pillar.

"That's 2510 Daisy Avenue off Choctaw Road way down there in Standard Heights," Brignac said. "The house is all tore down now, but my sister had the picture and she said somebody ought to be able to create it."


Brignac agreed and let the idea bubble in his brain for a while as he considered the 2-D aspect of the photograph and its perspective.

"I looked and looked at the picture and I could see everything I was going to do on this thing except for the columns," Brignac said. "It took me about three years looking at the picture, then I figured, 'I got to make the ground go up.' That's what I got to."

"After I got that idea I could do anything."

He was 79 years old.

But "I could do anything" has been Brignac's mantra since 1935 when he built that Standard Heights home for his newlywed neighbor. He had to do "everything" ever since his father died when Brignac was *See Artist Martin Brignac, continued on page 12*

## LSU AgCenter, others offer green industry workshop

A risk management workshop for green industry professionals will be held Monday, Feb. 11, at the LSU AgCenter Hammond Research Station in Hammond.

The theme of the workshop is "Surviving Difficult Times – Managing Risk and Uncertainty in the Nursery Business." The program will include general risk management principles, business and financial management tools, marketing strategies and crop insurance, according to LSU AgCenter horticulture professor, Dr. Allen Owings.

In addition, updated nursery production budgets from the AgCenter will be presented. Guest speakers will include Drs. John Haydu and Alan Hodges from the University of Florida, Charlie Hall from Texas A&M University and Dr. Laurence Crane from National Crop Insurance Services.

Interested attendees are asked to pre-register by Wednesday, Feb. 6, to enable a headcount for workshop materials and a complimentary lunch. Same-day registration begins at 8:00 a.m. with the program scheduled from 8:30 a.m. until about 1:30 p.m.

"This is a great opportunity for green industry professionals to hear the latest on these important topics," Owings said.



### Farmer Idea Award goes to Ark. inventor

James Simpson of Cave Springs, Arkansas, vice president of Benton County Farm Bureau, earned the grand prize in the national Farmer Idea Exchange competition at the 2008 American Farm Bureau Federation's 89th annual convention held in New Orleans.

Simpson's invention, the double bale spike, allows a large tractor to move three round bales of hay, instead of the usual two bales, at a time. Two spikes are placed on the rear of a tractor with a front loader, a 50-percent increase in productivity.

"I'm shocked. I'm pleased," Simpson said. "If I'd gone home without the award, there would be no regrets. I've had a really good



time here visiting with people."

Simpson won a year's use of a New Holland TV-145 bidirectional tractor. New Holland has provided a year's free use of a tractor to the grand prize winner for 18 of the 19 years the program has existed.

"I do have a working farm and there's always a spot there for a tractor," Simpson said.

In addition, Simpson's invention was recognized as the "most cost-effective" entry in the competition, earning him an additional \$500 for winning that category. At current fuel prices, the fuel savings alone pays for the investment in tubing and scrap metal to make the double spike.

Simpson was one of two Arkansans invited to exhibit at the American Farm Bureau Convention.

Charles Adamson of Forrest City (St. Francis County) was recognized as a finalist for his invention of a Cattle Working Chute Stop Gate, a device which allows him to load and work cattle in a chute by himself.

"I keep going and do whatever I can at the church. I'm always doing something at the church."

He took on the assignment to carve the 7-foot crucifix at St. Patrick Catholic Church in 2004.

"They asked me to do the tree (the cross)," Brignac said. "After two weeks I asked them if they had found the corpus for the cross. I told them I thought I could do it. I made a smaller model of the face and they said have at it."

What made Brignac, at age 83, think he could carve a beautiful rendering of Christ on the cross? It was the old Martin Brignac "I can do anything" mentality.

"I never carved anything," Brignac said. "I worked in cabinet shops in my time coming up. I built the dormer windows of the Governor's Mansion. I built the bow windows and most of the curved work. You want to make a nice smooth curve.

"I just was adept at doing that stuff."

Brignac feels his real work has just begun.

"As long as the good Lord keeps me alive, why shouldn't I give this back? It makes people feel good and they appreciate it."

## News from Texas

### TDA quarantines 32 counties to prevent spread of citrus psyllids

The Texas Department of Agriculture has quarantined 32 counties to prevent the spread of the Asian citrus psyllid, an insect that is capable of transmitting citrus greening, a disease in citrus plants that does not exist in Texas.

Psyllids have been detected in the following 32 quarantined counties: Aransas, Atascosa, Bee, Bexar, Brazoria, Brooks, Caldwell, Cameron, Dimmit, Duval, Harris, Hidalgo, Jim Hogg, Jim Wells, Kennedy, Kleberg, Live Oak, Matagorda, Maverick, McMullen, Nueces, Refugio, San Patricio, Starr, Uvalde, Val Verde, Victoria, Waller, Washington, Webb, Willacy and Zapata.

Nurseries and other citrus producers/sellers in the quarantined areas must enter a compliance agreement with TDA that requires a treatment plan for all psyllid host plants (primarily citrus plants) prior to sell-

ing and exporting to other counties within the state. Businesses that ship citrus plants to other states will need to contact USDA.

While the Asian citrus psyllid poses absolutely no threat to human health, its potential as a carrier of citrus greening is a cause for precautionary action. Citrus greening also poses absolutely no threat to human health, but is harmful to citrus fruit and plants. Citrus fruit in the quarantined areas and across Texas remains safe to eat. Still, TDA is taking a proactive approach to curtail the possible spread of the pest and the disease.

Department of Agriculture and USDA are implementing precautions to ensure containment of the citrus psyllids, which will minimize the chances of citrus greening being introduced and spread within the state," said Texas Agriculture Commissioner Todd Staples.

Texas is the second-largest state in grapefruit production and the third leading state in orange production, with about 28,295 acres in commercial citrus production in the Rio Grande Valley. The primary citrus counties are Cameron, Hidalgo and

"With a statewide economic impact of more than \$160 million, our citrus industry is a vital part of the agricultural economy and the economy of the Rio Grande Valley," Commissioner Staples said. "It is important to remember citrus greening does not exist in Texas, and our oranges and grapefruit are safe to eat and safe for domestic and export shipments. TDA will aggressively work with USDA and our industry partners to protect our vital citrus industry."

For the past year Texas A&M researchers have been conducting surveys across the state looking for citrus greening. To date, more than 1,200 citrus samples have been collected in Texas, all returning negative results. More than 1,100 samples collected by TDA in the citrus counties were also negative for the disease.

seven.

"I was the oldest boy of six children," Brignac said. "By the time I was 13, I not only built that house, I wired my mother's house to put

light switches in the wall to turn on the lights instead of fumbling for the string pull chain.

"I didn't know if I could build that house or not, I just went and did it.

When the fellow came and asked my mother if I could do it she said

yeah because she saw I did all kind of things around the house.

"I was fixing the kid's bicycles. I had the know-how and a reputation as the fix-it boy in the neighborhood."

After Brignac so lovingly built the 3-D model of his family home

and other neighborhood residences he turned his attention and considerable talent to recreating eight of Louisiana's most famous plantations.

He has built Laura, St. Joseph, Poplar Grove, Tezcucoc, Nottaway, Felicity, Magnolia Mount and Mount Hope. All of these facsimiles have been placed under glass and displayed at several plantation homes.

At first Brignac

took photographs of the antebellum homes and crafted a scale drawing of the building.

"I had to measure everything and bring it up to scale," he said. "It would take two or three weeks just to make the drawing."

It wasn't long before Brignac

experienced the joy of Kinko's and learned he could blow up a scale photograph up to scale.

Using balsa wood, a variety of Exacto blades and tiny clamps, Brignac found the process of building in miniature just as demanding and fulfilling as constructing a full-sized house.

He quickly recognized that his long experience in home building would aid him with the production of his tiny masterpieces, which can take up to three months to assemble.

"My training helped me with the short cuts," Brignac said. "When I measure stuff here I know the tricks how to multiply it out."

Using paint and a number of high-quality paint brushes, Brignac is able to recreate the look and texture of the old plantation homes.

Illustrating brick work gave him trouble, however.

"I figured I would just paint with watercolors for the bricks," Brignac said.

The problem?

"Watercolored painted brickwork looks just like watercolors. What could I do to make the brick details look more like brick? I got this wild idea in my head that the best way to make brick was to use brick," he said.


Brignac simply chipped a piece of brick from the masonry and crushed it into fine particles. He applied glue to the material surface, then uses salt and pepper shakers to sift the brick dust onto the sticky facade.

"You can get the exact color of the brick," Brignac said. "I can use a razor to cut the units. Instead of having one little piece at a time, I can take these things and offset them and it makes it look just like you're stacking bricks."

At 86, Brignac has only slowed down slightly. He's thin, but he was always lean.

"I guess you can stay slim from swinging a hammer," Brignac said.


